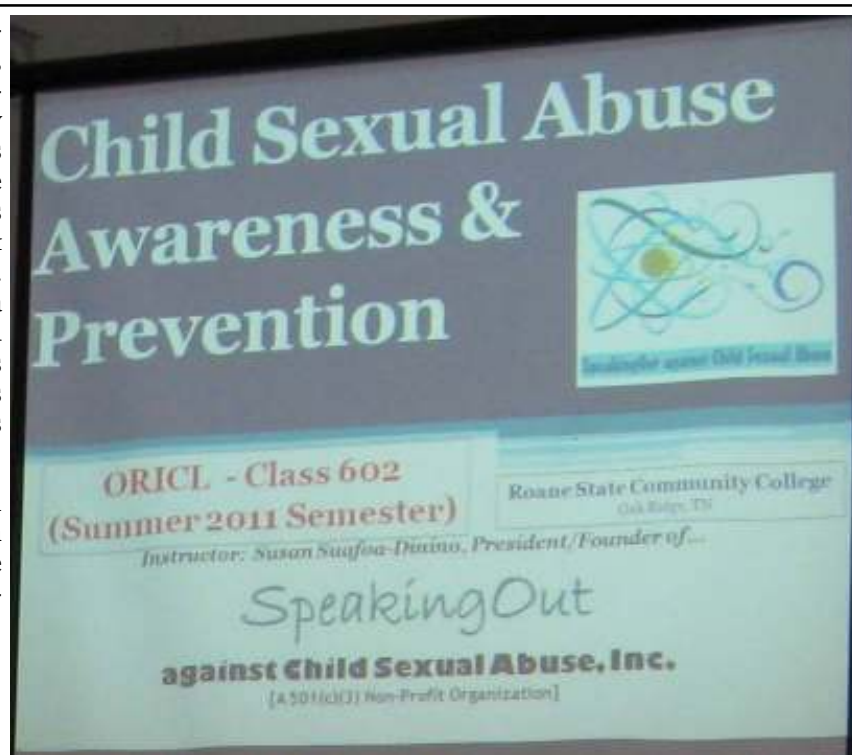


SpeakingOut Class - Summer 2011 Semester

- Message to parents on prevention
- Message to survivors of childhood sexual abuse



Susan Suafoa-Dinino is the President/Founder of a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Organization called SpeakingOut against Child Sexual Abuse, Inc. (aka SpeakingOut) and spends the majority of her time SpeakingOut on behalf of all children who have ever been, are being or will be sexually abused. Having spent every day for the past 12 years dealing directly with this crime and its long-lasting effects on a personal level, as well as through years of research, she feels strongly that child safety begins at home, or at least it should. Susan is originally from Louisiana, has lived all over, and has resided in Oak Ridge, Tennessee since 2006. She previously served in the United States Army and is a mother of two sons.
