Statistics show that this crime is very real & more rampant than ever in today's society.

We are working vigorously to remove two of the greatest obstacles in protecting children from Sexual Abuse...Denial and Lack of Education. Child Sexual Abuse is everyone's problem, and it will take everyone fighting this fight to aid in the prevention of this horrific crime. As we raise public awareness by educating all who will listen, we are working to break down the barrier of denial and thus foresee that society will play a huge role in raising awareness and making America a safe place for children.

It is our belief that, in most cases, Parents are not educated on this topic until after a child has been sexually abused. Children who are violated in this horrific way have no choice but to think about it & in most cases will not tell anyone. These children suffer alone. It is imperative for the safety of children... all Children, that we talk openly in our homes and publicly about this crime... and it is a Crime!

### Message from the President/Founder



"In the year 2000, I was faced with a very real issue in which I was unfamiliar...the horrifying truth & reality of Child Sexual Abuse. As with most people, I was naïve & uneducated on this topic. So I began to research this horrific crime. But what I found was so disturbing that I have never felt so helpless. Since that time, I have been trying to figure out a way to help children who are Sexually Abused. Every single day across America, countless numbers of children are sexually violated. And there are so many obstacles to overcome in order to help just one child, much less the multitudes of Sexually Abused children. The task seemed impossible once I read the statistics and learned about the failures of the systems in place that are supposed to protect children. The truth is that we live in a fallen world in which many children are robbed of their innocence by Sexual Predators. And they prey on

children of all ages. As a Mother of 2 wonderful sons, it is my belief that children should be loved and cherished, but more often than you or I would like to believe, they are molested and raped. This sickens me. My heart aches for these hurting children.

Most of the children who are Sexually Abused will never tell anyone. And the majority of children who do disclose are not being believed and/or protected by "the system". According to MASA (Mothers Against Sexual Abuse), "only 25% of Child Sexual Abuse cases are ever reported; 5% of those will never go to court; 50% of those children will be returned to the alleged abuser." You do the math. I have felt for a long time that I have to do something... that I must speak up for these most innocent of victims... Children. But I have also felt that there was no way I could make a difference. Over time, I've come to realize that I can no longer focus on what I cannot change & began to focus on what can be done. I believe whole heartedly that we can help "one child at a time" by "SpeakingOut". We can make a difference! It's time to "Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves..." (Proverbs 31:8).

The way I see it...its time to uncover this hidden crime. The safety of children... all children depends on it. By SpeakingOut against Child Sexual Abuse, we can show the multitudes of hurting children across America that someone does care, thus encouraging children to "tell" on their abuser. In addition, we can begin to take a more proactive approach to this crime by aiding in the prevention of it... stopping it before a child is violated. And last but not least, we, as a society, will send a message to all who prey on innocent children that we will no longer sit idly by while they harm unsuspecting, innocent children. We will reveal not only what they do to children, but how they silence them.

#### Do You Know the Facts?

**Truth and Reality...** Child Sexual Abuse is a huge issue in today's society...all across America. The statistics are staggering, and we urge you to keep in mind that each "statistic" represents a real child. Here are just a few facts that every adult in America needs to be aware of...



It is estimated that
1 in 5 Boys
&
1 in 3 Girls

will be sexually violated at some point during their childhood (before the age of 18)

For some children, it is a one time violation, and for others, it is an ongoing occurrence throughout their childhood. Most children will never tell anyone during their childhood, which means these children suffer alone. You may be surprised to learn how many victims of childhood sexual abuse never speak of their abuse until some point well into their adulthood. And then there are those adults who, to this day, have never spoken of the horrible violation(s) committed against them as children. The shame that seems to be attached with being a victim of this type of violation is a shame that <u>does not</u> belong to the victim, but rather the perpetrator and only the perpetrator. **It is NEVER the child's fault**, regardless of age, circumstances or who their perpetrator is. When an adult sexually violates a child of any age, regardless of their reason, he or she has abused the authority that adults have over children, and in the most horrific way.

How we, as a society, look at and handle this crime against innocent children plays a huge role in how child & adult victims feel and respond. We must do a much better job at placing the blame where it belongs. We must stop sweeping this issue under the rug because it is an uncomfortable and disturbing thing to think about. Unfortunately, the problem will not go away by itself. As adults, we must step up and take action. Everyone can do something to fight against this crime.

The majority of children who are sexually violated (approximately 95%)

know the person that is abusing them, and in many cases, love and trust that person.



Because of this fact, many people have the mindset that this is a personal issue that should not be discussed openly or outside of the home. Far too many adults keep it a secret even when they know a child or their child has been violated. They don't want anyone to know. This thinking is incorrect, harmful & does absolutely nothing to help the child. The molesting, raping & exploiting of children of any age is a CRIME and should be handled as such. As adults, our # 1 Priority must be to protect children... all children. We are responsible for their safety and wellbeing.
